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Hereditary Cancer Management Program

This VisualAbstract was created by
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63 Completed Patient Intakes:

48% were diagnosed with a malignancy or benign tumor prior to referral



Genetic counseling and risk assessment



Provide a medical home for hereditary cancer patients



Coordination of specialty care referrals and screenings



92% of patients have a confirmed genetic mutation



Each patient sees over 2 specialists



9.5% of patients were diagnosed with malignancy or benign tumor following screening



Manage cancer screenings based on guidelines



Prevent malignancies or identify at earlier stage



Increase life expectancy
