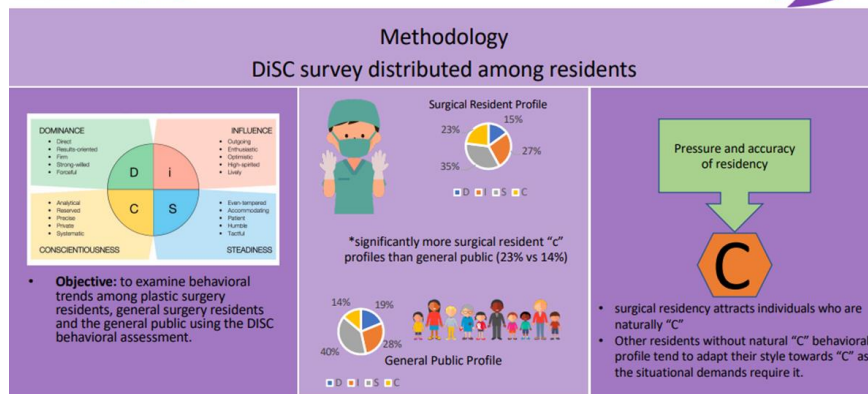

Analyzing the Orthopaedic Surgery Personal Statement (PS): Do Applicants See Value in Its Use?

Survey sent to 978 orthopaedic surgery applicants



20.9% response rate



10-15 hours to write



All female students sought editing help; 7% male students did not. Men used physician mentors; women used peers to edit (p = 0.05)



79.4% of applicants believe the PS is valuable and should continue as a part of the residency application
